Sorry we didn't put out a newsletter in May. I sent out so many messages that I felt that was enough. Those of us who were not working during the lockdown had lots of time to pray, read scripture, attend online masses and seminars, and watch youtube videos etc. It was like being on retreat for many of us.

Various international groups have put lots of material online so we have loads of material for ongoing spiritual support and learning. I will mention some websites in this newsletter. The Service Group is having some work done on our website at present and then we hope to add links to useful resources.

In May we had 3 meetings with prophecies and we have looked at these to see what the Holy Spirit is saying to us. Actually the message we have been getting is not just for those in the Renewal but for all Christians. The scriptures above sum it up.

Pope Francis wrote in his apostolic exhortation, Evangelii Gaudium - The Joy of the Gospel, about the importance of a daily encounter with Jesus.

Paragraph 1. The joy of the gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. Those who accept his offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness. With Christ joy is constantly born anew.

Paragraph 3. I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day.

We must stay connected to Jesus through our daily quiet time, read God's Word daily, listen to God daily.

We are being sent in the power of the Holy Spirit to share Gods love and healing, to teach, to bring people to experience a personal encounter with Jesus, to invite them to be baptised with the Holy Spirit.

Encourage your parish to run Alpha, and Life in the Spirit Seminars. Offer to help with parish programs.

Are You Abiding in Christ? How Fruitful is Your Life?

We are being sent out to bear fruit.

We need to be equipped to go out.

The prayer groups offer a place where we can be filled afresh with the Holy Spirit. The prayer group is a place to develop our knowledge, gifts and charisms and confidence. Share testimonies to encourage one another. Have teachings on the charisms and follow with workshops to practice using them. Pray for one another and practice using the charisms in a safe environment.

Introducing Jesus Youth: one of the Currents of Grace in NZ

Jesus Youth is an international Catholic movement approved by the Holy See and present in over 25 countries, including in all the 6 dioceses of New Zealand. The movement challenges young people to live a meaningful, creative and fulfilling life.

The strength of the movement is its special focus on a life centered on the Lord Jesus Christ through a faithful living of the Six Pillars viz. Prayer, Word of God, Sacraments, Fellowship,

Evangelization and an Option for the poor. Jesus Youth is a network of small but vibrant groups of young people who in their own life situations strive to give time to the Lord, responding to the challenges of today's world in the power of the Holy Spirit.

In Auckland we have an active group of about 30 youth and a few families. We have a youth prayer meeting every week at 3:30 pm at the Pompallier Centre and a family prayer meeting that takes place once a month in the house of one of the families on a rotational basis.

Our activities mainly revolve around the prayer meeting, organizing hours of mercy (12 hours Eucharistic Adoration during the period between Easter and Pentecost) at one of the parish Churches, outreaches to rest homes, music ministry, media ministry, formation courses, etc.
