Chairpersons message for ACCPGN newsletter Jan-Feb 2023

Acts 1: 8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Dr Mary Healy began her talk at the recent Current of Grace Conference with discussion about a spiritual revival that began on February 8th, this year, at a university in a small American town called Ashbury. At a normal evening prayer service the students experienced the anointing of the Holy Spirit so they continued praying and praising God through the night and over the next 2 weeks. Word spread and about 20,000 people from across USA and the world came to the small town of about 6000 people to experience the presence of God.

Dr Mary said God is awakening his church and wants us to be rejuvenated in the Holy Spirit, ready to steward and pastor his people.

I encourage you to go to the movie, Jesus Revolution, 2023, in theatres at present. The true story of a national spiritual awakening in the late 1960s, early 1970s and its origins within a community of teenage hippies in Southern California. Producer Jon Erwin told the audience at Liberty University that they wanted to tell the story of the last great awakening in America because he believes it's

Dr Mary said Jesus began his mission in the power of the Holy Spirit and she told us to continue it in the power of the same Holy Spirit.

Guidelines on Prayers for Healing 2007, revised 2017, and Deliverance Ministry 2021.

The service group are organizing teachings on Sat July 8th and Sept 9th, to help you all grow in knowledge and confidence when praying for others and activating your gifts.

We hope to see you all at our Pentecost Celebration, Sunday 28th May, 4pm, at Christ the King church, Mt Roskill. A Pentecost Novena prayer is attached. Please pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. We need the power of the Holy Spirit to be effective witnesses of God's love in our world.

<u>Charis international updates from Helen</u> <u>Smithson, Charis NZ coordinator.</u>

I attended the Asia/Oceania Continental Service of Communion Meeting 10-12 March 2023. The main focus of the meeting was to vote on various nominations for CHARIS International General Assembly to be held in Rome 29-31 October 2023. According to the statutes, a General Assembly should occur every 3 years with those elected serving a maximum of 6 years. (This has been extended one year due to Covid)

Shayne emphasised at the Continental elections a directive was received from Rome to have continuity rather than change for this round of elections. However Bro James Shin chose to standdown and Fe M. Barino from the Philippians was elected as the third continental representative along with Cyril John - India and Shayne Bennett Australia, both re-elected.

The CHARIS General Assembly is to be held in Rome 29 - 31 October to vote for members for CHARIS International Service of Communion. The General Assembly is an important part of establishing relationships throughout the CHARIS structure. Diana Ingle, as Asia/Oceania Continental Ministry Representative will attend and I am available to represent us. The Assembly will be followed with Workshops on Commissions on November 1 and "Called, Transformed and Sent" - completing a 2 year CHARIS Integral Formation Program on November 2-4.

Both Josephine Olsen and I are attending the CHARIS Worldwide Intercessors Conference at Ivory Coast on 2-6 May. I am sure it will bring many blessings to our nation as New Zealand is prayed for and in return we pray for others. A month or so ago there were over 40 nations being represented. Please pray for our protection and all travel arrangements as well as the conference itself.

A suggested Novena prayer to help us start using charisms or deepen the way we are using them. Please pray daily until Pentecost. (From Jean Christophe Sakiti, Charis leadership course)

The talks were excellent. Every speaker addressing the main theme of gathering together as one body and moving in the Holy Spirit, as directed by Pope Francis. We all rejoiced in that we now have a seat at the table in the Vatican, in the Dicastery of the Laity, Life and Family. It has taken 50 years to achieve this recognition, so indeed we feel our life's work has been well worth it. Mary Healy zoomed in from USA with a challenging and inspiring message for us to really take on board the mandate to share what we have been given by God. We enjoyed all the talks, especially Robert Falzon from Australia who heads up Men Alive ministry to draw Catholic men to take up the important role of fatherhood in their families (the Little Church) and then, only then, to work in the Bigger Church as God directs.

The Conference opened with "The Blessing Aotearoa/New Zealand" led by a wonderful Praise and Worship team. A fitting start to a long-awaited weekend, which had been previously postponed twice over the last two years.

I welcomed all, followed by an opening address by Cardinal John Dew. This was prerecorded as Cardinal John was recovering from very recent surgery. Mons Frank Eggleton then encouraged us all to celebrate as one body within our parishes and across cultures.

Saturday morning Dr Mary Healy via live video link gave a great wake up call, sharing her passion, knowledge and enthusiasm to encourage us all to receive the Holy Spirit and to use all His gifts to fulfil the commission each person receives at Baptism to go and make disciples. The same Holy Spirit is available to us today as on the day of Pentecost.

Robert Falzon from Brisbane Australia, cofounder of MenALIVE, was real and passionate, sharing his journey and encouraging and stimulating all to action. He also led - Gospel Families - one of the four optional workshops on Saturday afternoon.

Diana Ingle led "Hearing God's Voice -Personally and Collectively". Lucienne Hensel led "Your Story for God's Glory" and Susilo Kentjana - "Unlocking Your Gifts".

Father John Rea led a very powerful Saturday afternoon session on Miracles, Signs and Wonders. Jesus is healing today as in the Acts

of the Apostles "you will do greater things when I return to the Father." The Holy Spirit was truly present, touching people's hearts and lives. This continued into the evening session "Let the Fire Fall - An Upper Room Experience"

The wonderful music team led by Wilma and Mike Conroy enabled us to join the choirs of heaven to worship our Lord.

On Sunday, Robert Falzon sent us out with a message to go and do all we were created to be and do. We each have a role in life which we were born for.
