Do you keep taking the same sin to Reconciliation? Lent is coming. This is a time when we are asked to focus on growing in holiness. Maybe this recurring sin or bad habit is what we need to work on this Lent.

On Feb 22 we had a retreat for ACCPGN prayer group members titled Pursuing Gods Purpose. I give thanks to Noel Tauro and Nigel Fernandes for the prayer and time they put into preparing for this retreat. Also I give thanks to Fr Rory, the whole service group and to members of the prayer groups and others who stepped up to help make the day a special one.

Antonio Pereira spoke about our need to discern God's purpose. He gave us 5 keys to pursuing God's purpose, relating these to the Gospel story of the disciples catching many fish. Luke 5:1-11. Steps 1. Pursue God with all your heart. 2. Know God will direct you through his Word so read it and reflect on what you read. 3. Expect God to move supernaturally, step out in faith. 4. Be humble. Even when successful remember your need for God. 5. Know God has better plans for you.

Richard Pereira spoke on Union with God. The message was based on John 17. eg John 17:21b 'As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.' When we develop our relationship with God through quiet prayer time, we will be filled with his love and this love will flow from us to others.



How to check if News or photos are fake News

Al's capabilities are growing, including its ability to generate increasingly realistic photos. The good news is that there are ways to figure out what's real and what's not. Here are two quick and easy methods to try -

1. Try a reverse Google Image search - Popping an image into Google's reverse search functionality will show you where else it is being used and if these are legitimate, trustworthy sources. Click here for a tutorial.

2.Try fact-checking by asking Google - As we've done below, a quick search of 'Did the Hollywood sign burn in the 2025 LA fires' resulted in articles from verifiable news sources that revealed the images were, in fact, fake.
